## Key points of the implementation of the Summer Training Course of the Service Learning Program at Asia University

- 1. These Implementation Points shall be formulated in accordance with the "Implementation Points for Service Learning" of the University. All matters relating to the summer courses of the Service-Learning Programme of the University shall be handled in accordance with the provisions of these Points.
- 2. Fresh graduates and extended students of the University Day Department in the current academic year who need to take heavy (supplementary courses) due to failure of the service-learning course may apply for summer study and register for the course within the specified time.
- 3. The summer school homework is arranged by the extracurricular activities and service-learning team and published on the website or bulletin board of the group.
- 4. The total number of service days per subject during the summer vacation period shall not be less than 2 weeks, 5 days a week, 3 hours of service per day, and the total number of service hours per echelon shall be at least 30 hours. If the total number of actual hours of service is insufficient at the end of the original number of days of service for each tier, the Section will not be approved. However, if the Personnel Administration Bureau temporarily announces the suspension of classes at tertiary colleges due to natural disasters, the number of service hours during the suspension period does not need to be supplemented.
- 5. After the list of summer courses is announced, students should go to the extracurricular activities and service learning team to inquire about the list of group tiers, and shall not arbitrarily change the service tiers, except for irresistible factors with the consent of the supervisor.
- 6. Any student who participates in the summer study has an impostor name, and once discovered, the student's qualification for the summer study of the subject will be revoked, and the student reward and punishment measures of the university shall be strictly punished. 7. This point has been approved by the Council on Service-Learning and promulgated for implementation after approval by the Principal, and the same applies when amended.
